FTLife promotes equal learning opportunities By presenting FTLife Scholarships to students making academic improvement

True to its charitable corporate culture and its dedication to "protection and succession", FTLife has established the 3-year FTLife Scholarships for students receiving the free one-on-one tutorial service from "Principal Chan Free Tutorial World". The Awards aims at encouraging those students who make significant academic improvement after receiving the learning support. Students from different educational levels are covered, ranging from junior primary school to senior secondary school. Also, those who got good results from the HKDSE are eligible for the Awards.

FTLife Vice Chairman and Executive Director Fang Lin, alongside the management team and regional directors, attended the Annual Recognition Ceremony of "Principal Chan Free Tutorial World" on 4th January. The ceremony gathered the volunteer teachers, students, parents, guests and representatives of the supporting organisations. This year, around 350 students received the FTLife Scholarships.

In his opening speech, officiating guest Mr Fang said, "FTLife deeply believes in the life-changing power of knowledge and love. We fully support deprived children to enjoy equal learning opportunities so that they can enrich themselves with knowledge and aspire to something bigger. In the welcoming speech, Mr. Chan Hung, founder of "Principal Chan Free Tutorial World", said, "We attach great importance to the growing value rather than the grown result. That is the reason why the FTLife Scholarships are given to students who make improvement and strive for a better future!"

Founded in 2011, "Principal Chan Free Tutorial World" is a non-profit organisation recognised by the Government. It gathers volunteers from all walks of life and provides learning supports to underprivileged children so that they can enjoy equal opportunities in learning. The champions, first and second runners-up from various groups were chosen after interviewing with a panel of judges consisting of representatives from FTLife and volunteer teachers of "Principal Chan Free Tutorial World".
